In our continued effort to provide safe and high quality drinking water to our customers, the Clifton Water District will be performing our Unidirectional Flushing Program and flushing fire hydrants in our system from October 30, 2017 through the end of November 2017 (as weather permits). The District's flushing activities is to occur between the hours of 8:00 am to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Only minimal impacts such as reduced water pressure and a temporary discoloration of the water should affect our customers.

Hydrant flushing is scheduled to take place Monday through Friday in the following areas:

- **October 30 through November 3 – Areas between 32 Road and F.5 Road and work west to 30 Road**
- **November 6 through November 10 – Areas between 30 Road east to 32 Road north of F.5 Road**
- **November 13 through November 17 – Areas between F.5 Road and F Road between 30 Road and 32 Road**
- **November 20 through end of November – Areas between F Road and E.5 from 32 Road and work west**

The Unidirectional Flushing Program using Fire Hydrants to flush water at a high velocity through distribution water lines is a critical procedure in maintaining the District's distribution system to ensure the delivery of the highest quality of water possible. The Unidirectional Flushing Program is effective in scouring the distribution water lines while minimizing water loss and performing valve and hydrant exercising. During this process the District collects valuable information concerning the volume and quantity of water available from fire hydrants for use in fire protection.
