Door to Door Water Testing Reported

Salespeople are not affiliated with area water providers

GRAND JUNCTION, CO January 21, 2013—Several water customers have recently reported being contacted in their homes by salespeople asking to sample and test their water.

Neither the City of Grand Junction Water, Ute Water Conservancy District, nor Clifton Water District are doing any water testing of this nature. This is simply a company that would like to sell some type of product to customers, and is not sponsored or endorsed in any manner by any of the area water providers.

If contacted by someone coming door to door, always ask for identification. Employees of any of the three area water providers would be using an official company vehicle and would be wearing company clothing or have a picture ID to identify themselves as an employee.

All three water utilities have sampling stations at various locations around the community to be able to sample water in the system without going door to door.

There are some instances when you would receive a visit from a water employee, such as if you had reported a taste or odor problem with your water. On occasion the water utility may need to run a specific water test, but they would contact the resident ahead of time to get permission to do that testing.

Water Testing/add 1

All three water providers test the water in their systems to meet stringent Federal water quality standards. All three also publish an annual Consumer Confidence Report listing the compounds found in their water. This information is available from your water provider, or is available online on their individual websites.

We are fortunate in the Grand Valley to have a high quality source of water that is regularly tested and is safe to consume.
